

WTC Announces the City of Alma is a Go for Fiber Network

Wamego, KS, 03-17-2020 — Alma (KS) may be the 'City of Native Stone', but soon they will also be the 'City with Fiber'. Within just 4 short weeks of hearing about WTC's plans to bring Fiber-to-the-Premise technology to the community, the community has already met the 70% pre-signup goal needed by WTC to proceed with a fiber buildout.

"With the way most people live their lives today, Internet service is no longer just a want, it has become a basic need. Having consistent and reliable high-speed Internet service is an expectation," stated Karen Wright, City Council member for the City of Alma. WTC will now finish engineering the project with hopes of beginning actual construction as early as April 2020. Over the next several months, customers can expect to hear from WTC, as technicians conduct site visits to determine the best location to bring the fiber into their homes and businesses. Assuming no major obstacles or weather delays, WTC hopes to start transitioning customers to their services late this year and into the first part of 2021.
