WTC Announces the Rossville Fiber Network is a Go!

Wamego, KS, 04-14-2021 — Rossville (KS) can now rest assured they will soon be a community no longer left behind on the Internet Superhighway. Within just 2 short months of hearing about WTC's plans to bring Fiber-to-the-Premise (FTTP) technology to their town, the community has already met the 70% pre-signup goal needed by WTC to proceed.
